The scheduled budget meeting of the Potter Township Board of Supervisors was held Monday, October 16, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. in the Potter Township meeting room, 124 Short Road, Spring Mills, PA with Supervisors Dick Decker, Melvin Dutrow, Denny Foust, Karl Eysenbach and Jake Tanis attending.

At 7:10 P.M. Chairman Decker opened the meeting of the Potter Township Supervisors with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Special Presentation – Representatives of Centre Hall Fire Company, Kenny Strouse and Brian Long, discussed the numerous bids received for the construction of a new fire house. There was exchange of ideas regarding design plans for bidding, cost estimates for bids received, possible alterations to plans, equipment, funding, and location of proposed firehall. A town meeting was recommended.

A letter opposing House Bill 1469 was reviewed and signed. The letter will be sent to Senator Jake Corman and State Representative Kerry Benninghoff.

The \$20,000 grant received for Potter Run Park has been utilized for the construction and equipment at the Park. Mr. Foust made a motion to close the bank account for Potter Run Park, seconded by Mr. Tanis. **Motion carried 5-0.**

At 9:25 P.M. the regular meeting adjourned by motion of Mr. Tanis, seconded by Mr. Foust. **Motion carried 5-0.**
