### **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES**

The Commission completed its review of the Chris Cole Sewage Planning Module for the proposed subdivision off Taylor Hill Road. Mr. Henning recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the module. Ms. Lake seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

The Commission received the Construction Notice from Centre County Planning and Community Development Office for Transducer Works and a Time Extension for All Storage Solutions.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

The Commission received two requests to have properties along US Route 322 be rezoned from Prime Ag to Planned Commercial Industrial. Since the requests were received shortly before the start of the meeting and since the Commission members did not have an opportunity to review the requests, no action was taken. It was pointed out that plans need to be submitted to the Commission the Friday before the Commission's meeting.

Following a discussion on future work items, Mr. Troyan volunteered to review the Township's zoning regulations.
