THE PENNS VALLEY REGIONAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE 2024

Whereas, the boroughs of Centre Hall & Millheim, along with the Townships of Gregg, Haines, Miles, Penn and Potter, established joint efforts to develop and update a multi-municipal comprehensive plan and subsequent plan updates in accordance with the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (PA-MPC).

Whereas, the boroughs of Centre Hall and Millheim, along with the Townships of Gregg, Haines, Miles, Penn and Potter, established and appoint representatives to the Penns Valley Regional Planning Commission (PVRPC) whose advisory responsibility is to prepare the comprehensive plan update.

Whereas, the PVRPC prepared comprehensive plan updates to elements of the existing and adopted 2006 regional comprehensive plan that are subject to the most change and present the most pressing community issues as advised: Future Land Use, Demographics, and Public Safety.

Whereas, copies of the proposed Penns Valley Regional Comprehensive Plan Update 2024 have been forwarded to the Centre County Planning Commission, the Penns Valley Area School District, and the contiguous municipalities for review and comment in accordance with the PAMPC.

Whereas, the PVRPC held a public hearing in accordance with PA-MPC provisions and have provided a favorable recommendation to their respective bodies to adopt by resolution the updated elements as an amendment to the 2006 existing and adopted regional comprehensive plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that after considering the recommendations and comments received, Potter Township hereby adopts the Penns Valley Regional Comprehensive Plan Update 2024, which is comprised of the maps, charts, text, data, and all other material constituting a part thereof, as a guiding document for the next decade.
