Recycling Mini-Grant Recipients Announced

The Centre County Recycling and Refuse Authority (CCRRA) is excited to announce the award recipients of the 2024 CCRRA Recycling Mini-Grant.

The CCRRA mini-grant provides reimbursement grant funding for Centre County based projects that improve recycling education and collection of source-separated materials to be processed by CCRRA. During this grant round, CCRRA awarded a total of \$44,755.50 (see breakout below).

Congratulations to the 2024 Recycling Mini-Grant award recipients:

- State College Borough; Public On-Street Recycling Container Replacement; \$11,380.00
- Centre Region COG; Public Parks Recycling Container Replacement and Education; \$8,220.50
- The Pennsylvania State University; Recycle Coach Web & Mobile Education App; \$15,000.00
- The Pennsylvania State University; Dormitory Recycling Container Program; \$3,405.00
- Ferguson Township Lions Club; Re-paving/Widening Public Drop Off Recycling Location; \$6,750.00

CCRRA plans to offer another Recycling Mini-Grant opportunity in the spring of 2025 and encourages projects that will increase the quantity and quality of recycling in Centre County. Look for more information on our next grant round early next year.

RECYCLE

MIXED PAPER, PAPERBOARD, MAGAZINES & NEWSPAPER

Must be bagged or bundled together or they will not be accepted. Bag shredded paper. Place inside bin.



PLASTIC - BOTTLES, JUGS & JARS

Rinse containers. Lids and labels acceptable.



GLASS - BOTTLES, JUGS & JARS

Rinse containers. Lids and labels acceptable.



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Break down all cardboard boxes. Place beside bin.



STEEL & ALUMINUM - CANS & FOIL

Rinse and remove food residue. Labels acceptable.

Did You Know?

CCRRA has been awarded a \$75,000 grant from the West Penn Energy Fund (WPEF) to support our new solar PV array installation. The 791.5-kilowatt solar system will be installed over three separate CCRRA buildings and is estimated to produce about 939,881 kwh/year, which will offset more than 100% of the facility's annual energy usage save the Authority an estimated \$2 million over the next 25 years.
