#### **PSATS Scholarship Program**

The Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors (PSATS) Scholarship Program has been designed to increase awareness and involvement in local government among young Pennsylvanians.

Four \$1,500 scholarships are available consisting of two Local Government Achievement scholarships and two Academic Achievement scholarships. Students may only win **one** scholarship but may apply for both scholarship types (with a separate application for each).

The **Local Government Achievement** scholarship is an opportunity for students to showcase outstanding citizenship through public service and participation in their community. The **Academic Achievement** scholarship will be awarded to students who exhibit enthusiasm towards education by maintaining high academic standards.

#### **Eligibility**

Interested applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Hold U.S. citizenship
- Reside in a Township of the Second Class in Pennsylvania
- Currently enrolled as a high school junior or senior
- Plan for post-high school education towards a degree, professional license, or certification in the fall of 2024.

### Requirements

Interested applicants must **attend at least one township meeting** and submit the following for scholarship consideration:

- Completed application form (online or paper copy).
- Personal accomplishments list of honors, leadership roles, and activities you have completed or are currently undertaking in school or local community. Please include years of involvement.
- Copy of high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must come from a township supervisor.
- An essay on one of the following topics:

**Local Government Achievement** – Recount a project, service, or event which you participated in that had a strong impact on you and/or your local community.

*Academic Achievement* – Describe the importance of local government within your community or across the state of Pennsylvania.

Essays must be at least 500 words, typed in 12-point font with double spacing. Each essay will be judged by an independent panel based on originality, knowledge of the subject matter, and grammar.

Completed applications must be received by **January 31.** Winners will be selected before the PSATS Annual Conference at the Hershey Lodge.
