MEETING MINUTES

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Roy Brodzina-Baseball University representative

Voiced concerns with converting PAC fields into a “multi-use” facility, currently being considered by the Board of Supervisors. It is currently a “regulation” (60/90) Baseball field and would less likely be used by them if portable “mounds” were in place.

It was reported that the B.O.S wants to see an increase in the use and profitability of the PAC fields. Mr. Brodzina says B.U. has the potential to increase practice time by 4 days per week by pulling from Centre County and surrounding areas such as Altoona, Tyrone, Lewistown, Philipsburg, Mifflinburg and Milton. Season would typically run from May through October with practices typically cutting back to 2 times per week in the fall.

Mr. Brodzina also reported that Head of Baseball University, Nate Frantz would like to create more tournaments as a means of increasing PAC field use and profitability.

It was requested by PTPR members that Mr. Brodzina and Mr. Frantz attend the next Potter Township B.O.S meeting on Nov. 21st. at 7:00pm to further discuss this topic.

It was recommended by PTPR members and township secretary (to the B.O.S) that a PAC field “committee” be created to assist in a detailed plan for the future of the PAC fields.
